

## EVERYTHING YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT THE 2019 HFC 48-HOUR FILM CHALLENGE

## **Creative Process**

Film production must take place during the official 48-hour time period, including: Script Writing, Rehearsal, Costume/Set Design, Filming, Editing, Rendering, Exporting, Uploading (via Vimeo or Youtube, WITH PASSWORD)

**Music & Photos:** Filmmakers must have rights to all music. Music may be previously recorded. Still photos may be used, and do not need to have been taken during the 48-hour period.

**Length & Content:** 7:00 minute time limit, strictly enforced. No extreme violence, gratuitous sex, or hurting/killing animals. HFC reserves the right to disqualify films for content. Title & Filmmaker(s) name must be included in film. Children may be filmed, with permission from their parent/guardian. (Screening event on 4/6/19 is a 16 yrs old & up event). Animation & special effects permitted, as long as they are created within the 48 hours.

**Preparation:** The ONLY work to begin prior to the 48-hour window is: Organizing Crew & Cast, Securing Equipment, Scouting/Securing Locations, Collecting/Recording Music

## **Entry Requirements:**

Required Film Elements: Will be posted on the Official HFC Facebook (Public) Page at 4:00 PM on Friday, March 29, 2019th.

There will be a required theme, prop, and line of dialogue. See Judge's Evaluation Form for details on how films are evaluated. **Liability:** Filmmaker(s) assumes all liability/responsibility while producing their film.

**HFC Membership:** At least 1 teammate per entry must be an HFC member residing in the state of Hawaii. Each team must have at least 1 representative at the 4/6/19 Screening Event, where we will announce our 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place winners and distribute their prizes. **Restrictions:** HFC Board Members & their immediate family members may not enter a film.

**No Distribution**: Films may not be made public online or screened publicly before the HFC April 6<sup>th</sup> Screening Event at Doris Duke Theatre.

## **How to Submit Your Film:**

- 1. Read through ALL the requirements/rules above.
- 2. Send us the LINK and PASSWORD to your film (via VIMEO/YOUTUBE) to: events@hifilmmakers.org and include:
  - A) Team Leader's Full Name (Must be current HFC Member)
  - B) Team Leader's Email & Phone Number
  - C) Name of Representative (usually Team Leader) and (1) Free Guest for Screening Event at Doris Duke Theatre on 4/6/19
- 3. You will receive a confirmation e-mail when we have received your film and confirmed we can watch it. We MUST receive your email with working link by 4:00 PM SHARP on Sunday, March 31. If your film is not received by 4:00 PM on Sunday, it will not qualify for the challenge. However, if your film is turned in late on Sunday, it can still possibly qualify for our Screening Event, so even if you don't make it by 4 PM, please send us your film as soon as possible!
